We are very happy to welcome you back to the library! However, for the first stage of our re-opening, library services will be very different.

Here is what to expect for our re-opening on Tuesday July 7th:

Hours

- Limited Hours:
Monday Closed
Tuesday 10:00 am - 5:00 pm
Wednesday 10:00 am - 6:00 pm
Thursday 10:00 am - 5:00 pm
Friday 10:00 am - 5:00 pm
Closed weekends and Stat Holidays

Facilities:

- Number of patrons in the building will be limited. Please be patient!
- We encourage patrons to do their best to limit their time in the library
- We recommend two family members in the library at a time
- No study space or seating areas - Chairs have been removed
- Our public washrooms will be unavailable
- Hand sanitizer will be available in the library
- We encourage you to wear a mask when social distancing is unavoidable
- Holds will be available for you to pick up
- We ask anyone coming in to look for items to use hand sanitizer before and after touching items
- We ask you to limit touching books while browsing in our stacks, however bins are available to quarantine books you touch.
- No in-library programs, all programs are available daily as a take home kit.

Library items:

- Items returned will be quarantined for 72 hours
- Please put all returns in our book drop, the slot is located outside by the front doors
- We are not able to request items from other TRAC libraries currently

Computers & other services:

- The library will have 2 computers available for emergency & job-related use
- Computer time limit will be 30 minutes
- Printing will be limited to self serve black and white copies at our standard rate
- Faxing & scanning will be unavailable
